
2021 RHODE IS YEAR IN REVIEW

MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

Dear Friends,

As I end my decade as CEO of the Rhode Island Free Clinic, I am inspired by the lives we have improved and the Clinic's transformation to a quality Medical Home for our fellow Rhode Islanders who desperately need healthcare access and equity. The past two years have been extraordinarily challenging, and unfortunately COVID remains on the forefront of care for the majority of our patients. The Clinic continues to provide testing and vaccinations as well as welcoming hundreds of uninsured Rhode Islanders seeking care. All of this would not be possible without your support of the Clinic's vital mission.

As I reflect on our collective accomplishments during the past decade, the following stand out. Together, we:

- *Eliminated the Monthly Lottery for New Patients* that had been in place for years;
- *Increased Access* for over 25,000 uninsured adults and providing more than 100,000 medical and dental visits, including 26 specialties;
- *Grew our Volunteer Corps and Community Partners* each year we now mobilize over 500 Medical, Dental, Behavioral Health and support Volunteers, 75 Community Health Partners, and 17 Academic Partners to support the Clinic's model of service;
- Honored Outstanding Community Partners and Physician Champions through our Annual Founders' Award and Stephen Brin Physician of Year Award;
- **Bolstered our Volunteer Corps** by hiring part-time Primary Care, Dental and Behavioral Health;
- Developed our Dental Program for uninsured adults, now providing comprehensive services;
- Expanded the Clinic to own and occupy two floors with state-of-the art Clinic rooms, including new Dental Operatories, and Physical Therapy and Telehealth Suites;
- Hosted one of RI's largest AmeriCorps VISTA Teams, with nearly 100 VISTA Members dedicating a year of public service to help build the Clinic's capacity;
- Raised 100% of the Clinic's budget each year in 2021, we raised our \$1.5 million operating budget and leveraged over \$7.5 million of additional In-Kind health resources for patient care;
- *Launched and Operated our COVID Response Site* to provide over 10,000 vaccinations and tests, and expanded Telehealth and Behavioral health to increase critically-needed care during the pandemic; and,
- *Welcomed our new Volunteer Medical Director*, Ross Hilliard, MD, and our new partnership with Brown Medicine to improve the Clinic's quality of care.







Founded in 1999, our Mission is to:
