As we begin our first full year of leadership, it is important to note that the mission of the Rhode Island Free Clinic has remained unchanged since its incorporation in September 1998- to provide free, comprehensive medical care and preventive health services to adults who have no health insurance and cannot afford those services; and to serve as an educational training site for aspiring health care professionals.

As the Ocean State's oldest and largest free clinic, we pride ourselves on consistently delivering culturally appropriate, high-quality primary, dental and behavioral health care through the dedicated volunteerism of over 500 doctors, nurses, medical assistants, students and neighbors. Bolstered by generous individual, corporate and foundation donors, the Rhode Island Free Clinic remains available to serve our medically uninsured adults with the dignity they deserve. With a **\$1.5 million dollar annual budget** leveraging **\$7.5 million dollars in in-kind services**, \$0.95 of every dollar goes directly to patient care. Without our volunteers, staff and donors, including many of you, the Rhode Island Free Clinic simply would not and could not exist.

In 2023, the Rhode Island Free Clinic will proudly commemorate its 25th anniversary! We look forward to celebrating this milestone with you and hope we can count on you to continue with us on the journey to ensure quality and equitable health care for all. 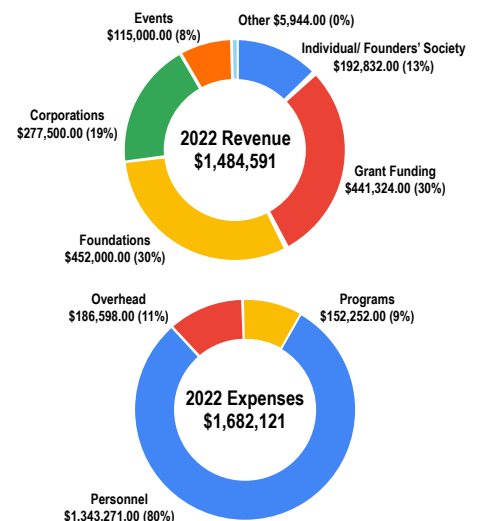

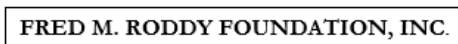
