# **POSITION SUMMARY**

**Data Analyst VISTA:** Reporting to the CEO, the Data Analyst VISTA will collaborate with clinical and administrative leaders to enhance the production of meaningful service, outcome, and quality information with improved use of technology, improved performance measurement tactics, and improved use and coordination of analytical collaborations.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Develop a newly created data warehouse to extract monthly reporting
- Collaborate with top medical professionals to collect, analyze, and interpret health data, benchmarking, and impact analysis to develop best practices.
- Champion data collection & reporting; creating new report formats and content, and producing accurate data reports.
- Works alongside with clinic, staff and community partners to build capacity by developing a module for data collection to measure and track patient performance outcomes. Also, assess productivity and quality of care provided with module. This includes: use current data systems, ECW, Volgistics and patient eligibility.
- Provide monthly reports on Clinic statistics including health indicators, volunteer model, and financial impact; design and implement data improvement projects on internal & external stakeholders; and assist with Clinic data goals.
